Entry fee: \$45.00 **Must be received by October 1, 2015 .**

Late fee: \$55.00 Door Fee is \$5.00 per family and will pay for the referees.

Eligibility: Open to current members of USJF, USJI, USJA. (Card required).

USJF registration will be available at tournament

Rules: Modified IJF rules, Contest area is 6.5M x 6.5M with safety area of 4.0M x 4.0M, no choking techniques allowed for those 12 years of age and younger. No Armbars allowed for juniors or if one or both competitors are below the rank of Sankyu. All competitors are required to wear a White gi if they are the first contestant called. Blue Gi's will **ONLY** be allowed on the second player called. Contestants will be provided a blue belt if they do not have a blue gi. This is for all divisions/ages.

From the south:

Take **I-95** North into New Jersey. Get off at **Exit 7B** (Lawrenceville) to **Route 206 North**. Follow to where 206 North takes a left (called Bayard Lane at that point) and take that left. At the first traffic light, turn right onto Paul Robeson Place. Paul Robeson Place becomes Wiggins St. Proceed 3/4 mile turn left onto Moore St. The School will be on your right. Make right onto Houghton Rd just prior to the school. Make left onto Walnut St. Entrance/parking lot and street parking is on the backside of the school.

From the north:

Take the **NJ Turnpike South to Exit 9** (New Brunswick). Bear right after the toll booth and follow NJ Route 18 North a short distance to US Route 1 South. Continue on **Route 1**, about 18 miles to the Route 571/Washington Road traffic light (an intersection with 2 gas stations. Make a right onto Washington Road. Drive into town and make right onto Rt 27 / Nassau St. Proceed three blocks and make a left onto Chestnut St. Chestnut St turns into Walnut St. The School will be on your left. Entrance/parking lot and street parking is on the backside of the school and on Walnut St.

1. I understand the nature of Judo activities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I also understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. I further acknowledge that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
